Award Categories:

_____ **Public Safety Hero:** An emergency responder who demonstrates extraordinary dedication and compassion through their work.

_____ **Youth Hero:** An individual, under the age of 18, who saves a life through rapid response and good judgment or has been trained to respond in emergencies or disasters.

_____ **Marylyn DeFeo - Good Samaritan Hero:** An individual over the age of 18 who makes a significant difference in the life of a person(s) or their community through their compassion and thoughtful actions.

_____ **Blood Donor or Volunteer Hero:** An individual who gives the gift of life on a regular basis either through regular blood donation or as an apherisis donor. Or a person who assists with local blood drives and works to ensure the community has an adequate supply of blood.

_____ **Military Hero:** A member of the Armed Forces who demonstrates extraordinary dedication and compassion through his or her work. This individual upholds and defends the values and traditions of the United States Armed Forces.

_____ **Business Hero:** A local business or business person that best demonstrates a partnership with his or her community. This person performs their service in accordance with the seven principals of the American Red Cross; Humanity, Impartiality, Neutrality, Independence, Voluntary Service, Unity, and Universality.

_____ **First Lady of Missouri Hero:** Given to the state employee living in central Missouri who has made a difference in the lives of their family, community, and state through their compassionate acts and commitment to making improvements in the lives of mid-Missourians.
